Greetings, Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Elders, Pastor Geml, our Ministry Staff, and others have been planning to safely begin live worship and other ministry activities.

On Sunday, June 14, 2020, our 9:30 a.m. Praise Service will be held in the Family Life Center and our 11:00 a.m. Traditional Service will be held in the Sanctuary. In order to assist you to safely attend one of these Services we ask you to follow the guidelines which have been set forth by our Governor as well as the following guidelines:

- 1. If you are feeling ill, please do not come to church. The Praise Service will continue to be broadcast by live streaming and the Traditional Service will continue to be pre-recorded and broadcast as we have in the past several weeks.
- 2. If you are considered high risk for complications if exposed to the Covid-19, please stay at home and participate in worship online.
- 3. If you park in the horseshoe, please enter and exit the Sanctuary through the automatic double doors at the end of the breezeway using the blue tape marking social distancing on the sidewalk and in the Transept. If you park on the streets around the Church, please enter and exit the Sanctuary through either the main doors into the Narthex or the side entry at the Chapel using the blue tape marking social distancing.
 - ALL OTHER ENTRY DOORS WILL REMAIN LOCKED. ONLY THE RESTROOMS IN THE NARTHEX WILL BE OPEN AND AVAILABLE.
- 4. Please consider using your mask while in the Sanctuary and the Family Life Center to protect others
- 5. Please use the hand sanitizers provided as soon as you come into the Church or the Family Life Center.
- 6. Please exercise the six-foot social distancing rule as you enter and leave the Church or the Family Life Center and during the worship services.
- 7. Every other pew in the Sanctuary will remain vacant. Pews to remain vacant are marked with tape. At the Praise Service, you will be responsible for getting chairs for you and your family and placing them in a group in the gym practicing social distancing from other worshippers. Assistance will be available if needed.
- 8. In the Sanctuary there can only be two family units (or less) in a pew with one family sitting on the center aisle and one family sitting on the outside aisle. The middle part of the pew

- should be left empty. Please select a pew that is nearest to the door you entered to minimize congestion when you leave.
- 9. In the Sanctuary, worship bulletins will be placed at the ends of the pews being used for seating. At the Praise Service, the worship service will be projected onto the screens as usual.
- 10. You will be ushered out of the Sanctuary to avoid congestion. Please exit the Praise Service practicing social distancing.
- 11. Offering plates will be available as you enter and leave, please place your offering there.
- 12. At this time, Communion will not be served during our regular services until a safe protocol is in place.
- 13. Sunday School classes and our nursery will not be available at this time.

As you can see our leadership has carefully come up with a plan for us to safely begin to gather to worship again. Please follow these guidelines as well as using your God-given common sense to remain safe while we are together in these times.

Other ministry activities may also begin again as directed by Pastor and Ministry Staff as long as safe protocols and practices are in place and are followed. All attendance and participation will be on a voluntary basis and no food will be served at this time at any ministry activity event unless provided by outside sources safely.

May God continue to bless us and keep us safe.
