 ${\tt P}$ In the name of the Father and of the ${\tt T}$ Son and of the Holy Spirit. C Amen.


- P On Ash Wednesday we come face to face with our fallen sinful nature. In Genesis, God created all life, but as Scripture declares, "sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin." *Romans 5:12*
- C And God declared to Adam, "You will return to the ground for dust you are, and to dust you will return. *Genesis 3:19*
- P Our foreheads are marked with ashes as a reminder of our mortality and our need for repentance. Yet, this ash is placed on us in the sign of the cross as a symbol of forgiveness and hope. As Job says with confidence, "I know that my Redeemer lives, and that in the end He will stand upon the earth."
- C "And even after my skin has been destroyed, yet in my flesh I will see God! I myself will see him with my own eyes!" Job 19:25-27

CONFESSION & ABSOLUTION

- P We begin our Lenten repentance by confessing our sins and hearing God's promise of forgiveness, which we will hear in its fullness at the conclusion of this season on Maundy Thursday.
- C I confess to Almighty God, before all the company of heaven, and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have sinned exceedingly in thought, word and deed through my fault, through my own fault, through my own most grievous fault; wherefore I pray almighty God, for the sake of Jesus Christ His Son, to have mercy on me, forgive me my sins, and bring me to everlasting life.
- P Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

NICENE CREED


