
Concordia Highlights April 17, 2021

Those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm (1Cor 11:27-29). Those who are not yet baptized, instructed, in doubt, or who hold a confession differing from that of this congregation and The Lutheran Church— Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the Sacrament, are asked first to speak with the pastor or an elder.





Reflection

You have been chosen by God with a purpose and a calling that He has predestined for you. He chosen this for you in keeping with His plan through Christ Jesus. He is the one who orchestrates everything in your life, from birth until death, and makes it agree with what He decides and wants. It is part of a plan that He had for you even before you came into being. You were chosen to be God's people, to live for Him, to love Him, to serve and worship Him. Nothing in your life goes unnoticed by your Creator, as He already had the events and circumstances of your life aligned with His will. He brought you into the gift of parenthood expecting you to teach your child about Him and His love for them. It is a responsibility that you cannot ignore or push aside. In fact, you should consider it an honor that the God of heaven and earth has selected you to such a position! Therefore, teach your child that he is not just your child, but he is God's child, too. It is God who has given him life and who lovingly watches out and protects him.
