A Letter from Pastor Geml

Dear members of Concordia,

Our history as a Christian Church has always pointed to God's means of grace given freely and generously in the Water and Word of Holy Baptism and the Body and Blood of Jesus received in the Holy Supper. In these blessed Sacraments, we receive forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation. The earliest practice of the Church was to commune young children when they had reached a level of understanding concerning Baptism and the Lord's Supper as well as a general understanding of the faith as communicated to us in the Bible. Unfortunately, this practice fell out of favor. Sadly, one of the results has young people leaving the Church in disturbing numbers. Often they gravitate to Churches who do not acknowledge or celebrate the means of God's grace. Young children who attend Concordia Lutheran Church are hearing about the blessings of Baptism and the Lord's Supper every Sunday. They are seeing the blessing of the Lord's Supper being received by others every Lord's Day. Some of these children already have a general understanding and a desire to receive the Body and Blood of Jesus. Connecting our young children to the Church is vital to our task of passing on, "The faith once delivered to the saints" (Jude 1:3). Along with the approval and direction of the Board of Elders, I am excited to announce an opportunity for parents to, "Train up their child in the way they should go... (Proverbs 22:6). Parents with children who are 10 years old and older will have the opportunity to learn about the blessings of receiving the Lord's Supper. After attending two 1-hour sessions with the Pastor, parents can decide if their child is ready to receive the Sacrament of the Altar. Parent/Parents will be required to attend these sessions with their child/children. Dates and times for these sessions will be determined soon. Please contact me or the Church office to register for this wonderful opportunity. May God bless and direct us in this time of learning and growing in faith.
